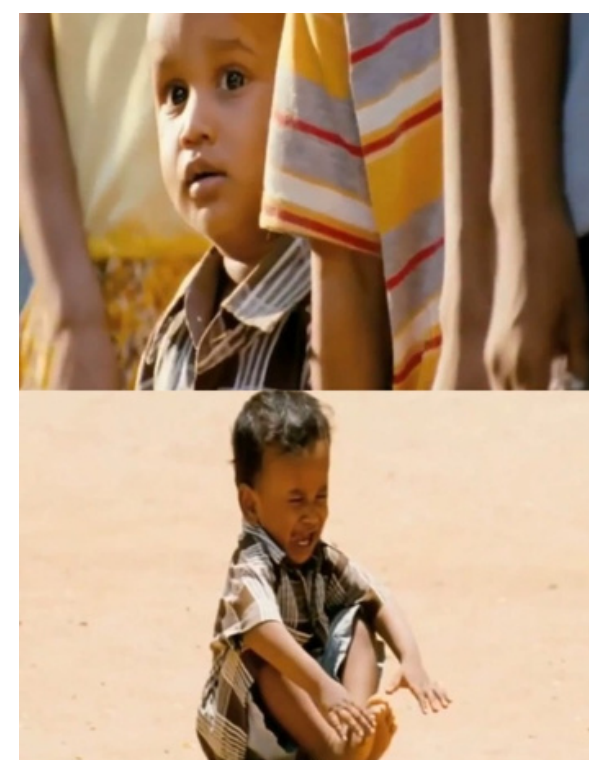
Our organization, 'Deva Kirubai Social Help Association' has been doing children's rights work and providing services for their socio-economic, educational, and health development in Trichy district for the past 31 years, with a special focus on children and poor rural people. For the past 4 years, our organization has been connecting the children who were in shelters with their families through the Family Based Alternative Care program and providing education, physical health and mental health improvements to the children and their family members, as well as providing many services in conjunction with government programs.

We are doing this project with the approval of Miracle Foundation India, the Central Government Social Security Department, the Child Welfare Committee, and the District Child Protection Unit.

At present, 166 children belonging to 107 villages in 13 districts are being educated in school, college, and various vocational educations in a safe environment with their parents and guardians.

We know children do not belong in institutional care; they belong in families. We also know that each child's journey back to the family is unique. As we lead the transition of children away from institutions, our job is to make sure this work is done in a safe, stable, and permanent way. The social workforce plan and oversee such reintegrations so that the child and family are safe, happy and thriving.



“Prevention is better than cure”



At the community level, our work activates and strengthens safety nets such as the Bal Panchayats, Village Level Child Protection Committees and Ward Level Child Protection Committees so that at-risk children and their families need the help they need at the right time.
